H.N.R.S. Neurobehavioral



Brief:

Hope Network, a recognized leader in the treatment and rehabilitation of brain injuries, determined that there was a need for a facility to house and treat people who have severe neuro-behavioral problems. This is one of only five in the country.

Strategy:

The facility was decided to be located at the south end of Hope Network's Behavioral treatment campus in Grand Rapids, MI. The building has three wings. The north wing is for administration and future bedrooms. The east and south wings are residential wings with four private bedrooms, communal living and laundry areas. The exterior of the building is similar to the rest of the camp. The interior uses extensive use of wood, relaxing colors and low intensity lighting.
